

SENIOR 2016-2017 TIMELINE OF EVENTS

The following senior activities require your attendance at practice. If you do not attend the following practices, you will not be allowed to participate in the senior activity.

- 1. Request forms for siblings to attend Senior Assembly are due to Mrs. Kathie Hyde, Room 100, by Friday, May 5, 2017.**
- 2. Senior Recognition and Awards Ceremony, Monday, May 15, 2017 at 6:30 p.m. in high school auditorium.**
- 3. Senior Assembly Practice-Thursday, May 18, 2017 at 3:30 p.m. in the competition gym. (*You must be present at practice to participate in Senior Assembly*).**
- 4. Senior Assembly- Friday, May 19, 2017 at 8:30 a.m. (*You must be in the practice gym by 7:45 a.m.*)**
- 5. Baccalaureate Practice-Friday, May 19, 2017 at 2:00 p.m. at First Baptist Church of Gun Barrel City. (*Remember that you will wear your cap and gown and stole to Baccalaureate as well as Graduation*)**
- 6. Baccalaureate-Sunday, May 21, 2017 at 2:00 p.m. at First Baptist Church of Gun Barrel City. (*All seniors must be at the church by 1:15 p.m. and meet in the education rooms to the left of the sanctuary*).**
- 7. Thursday, May 25, 2017- Senior Check-Out in Commons Area at 2:00 p.m. All fines and outstanding obligations must be cleared before Mr. Satterwhite will sign your**

final clearance form. This final clearance is a prerequisite for participation in graduation.

- 8. SENIOR WALK-Friday, May 26, 2017 at 7:45 a.m.- Board buses for Senior Walk at 7:30 p.m. You will wear your cap and gown, and you may also wear any organizational stoles or cords.**
- 9. Graduation Practice-Friday, May 26, 2017 at 9:30 a.m. in the competition gym at Mabank High School after the Senior Walk.**
- 10. Graduation- Friday, May 26, 2017-Curtis Culwell Center-Garland, Texas at 7:30 p.m. Entrance for guests by ticket only. Seniors will wear cap, gown, MHS stole and Beta or NHS stole, gold “honor graduate” cord and white “top ten” white cord only.**
- 11. All graduates must be at the Center by 6:00 p.m. and must park in the student parking lot of Naaman Forest High School.**
- 12. All visitors must pay \$10.00 for parking at the Center. (CASH ONLY). You may purchase a pre-paid visitor’s parking pass on-line at www.curtisculwellcenter.com for \$8.00. The Center encourages all visitors to order parking passes on line if possible.**
- 13. Graduation DVD’s will be on sale on the North Concourse at the Center on the night of graduation. The cost is \$25.00 per DVD and \$5.00 for shipping. You may pay with cash, Visa, or Mastercard. (NO CHECKS) It is**

the responsibility of each senior or family member to place the order on the night of graduation.

**DRESS CODE FOR SENIOR EVENTS
BACCALAUREATE AND GRADUATION**

GIRLS- Sunday dresses or appropriate pant suits with dress shoes (only dress sandals are allowed) with cap and gown. Spaghetti strap, halter top, and strapless dresses in *good taste* can be worn at these two senior events only! **REMEMBER, THE OPERATIVE WORDS ARE “*IN GOOD TASTE*”.**

BOYS- White or light colored shirts (button shirts only) with a dark tie and dress pants with dress shoes. (No blue jeans, shorts, sandals, tennis shoes, etc.) with cap and gown. **You must be clean shaven. All boys will absolutely wear a tie with their shirts or you will not be in Baccalaureate or Graduation.**

GIRLS- Nice dresses or pant suits and dress shoes or dress sandals. **ABSOLUTELY NO SPAGHETTI STRAPS, HALTER TOP, OR STRAPLESS ATTIRE. IF WORN, YOU MUST WEAR A JACKET, SWEATER, ETC.** Dresses must be the appropriate length.

BOYS- Dress shirts and pants and dress shoes. No blue jeans can be worn. You will absolutely not wear shorts, torn or ragged pants, hats, etc. (No sandals, shorts, tennis shoes, etc.). **You must be clean shaven.**
