- Index 3 Closing Performance Gaps: Closing Masters Grade Level gaps among student groups.
- ► Index 4 Postsecondary Readiness: Preparing students for postsecondary years by looking at percent of students at Meets Grade Level, Graduation Rate, Graduation Plan, and SY 15/16 graduates earning Post Secondary Readiness standard through TSI/ACT/SAT or earning credit for 2 advanced level courses or enrolled in a coherent CTE sequence.



Student Groups Evaluated

- Economically Disadvantaged (no Minimum Size Criteria)
- Up to 3 student groups evaluated in each subject area
- 2 lowest performing Race/Ethnicity groups meeting
 Minimum Size Criteria (25 students) from Index 1 in 2015
 - The 2 Performance Gap Groups are determined based on combined performance across all subjects
 - So the Performance Gap Groups evaluated in 2017 are the same in all subjects
 - Minimum Size Criteria for each Performance Gap Group in each subject area = 25
 - If a Performance Gap Group does not meet Minimum Size Criteria in a subject area, then it is not evaluated in that subject area
