1. **All seniors must fill out a diploma name form and return to Mrs. Kathie Hyde. Please print your entire name (as appears on birth certificate) legibly, sign, and date. Also indicate below your diploma name whether or not you have attended Mabank Schools from 1st-12th grade.**
2. **Any Senior interested in helping to select the senior T-shirt style needs to meet at 7:30 am -OR- 3:45 p.m. in Mrs. Smith's room, Room 130, on Wednesday, Sept 10, 2025. If you are interested in serving on this committee, please sign the sheet today before leaving. After selection of T-shirts has been made, flyers will be posted, and you will be able to purchase shirts from Ms. Smith. *Please listen for announcements.***
3. **All seniors will need to join the Class of 2026 Google Classroom. All senior information will be posted here! This is also where you will submit your baby pictures (see item 6).**

Anyone interested in planning, speaking, participating, or choosing the guest speaker for senior assembly must be at this meeting. *(Audition dates and guidelines for special performances will be available at an up-coming senior meeting.)*
9. March 2026 - Seniors will receive a *timeline of all senior activities and rules and regulations from the Curtis Culwell Center.* **You will sign for this. Your signature will indicate that you are informed of all activities and times, and you will be accountable for your attendance at all practices and events.**

11. May 1, 2026 - 1st day to send out graduation announcements.
12. Senior Scholarship Ceremony - Monday, May 11, 2026, at 6:00p.m. in high school auditorium.
13. May 14, 2026 - Senior Final Clearance in the commons area at 9am. All dues, fines, etc. must be paid before you are cleared to participate in graduation. No one will participate in graduation until they are completely cleared by Mr. Rowland.
14. Thursday, May 14, 2026, at 1:30pm - Practice for Senior Assembly in the competition gym. You must be at practice to participate in Senior Assembly. You will sit in alphabetical order.
15. Friday, May 15, 2026, at 8:30am - SENIOR ASSEMBLY in the competition gym. All seniors must report to the practice gym by 7:30 a.m. Proper dress and attire is required. All dress code requirements are included in this information sheet. If you are not in compliance with the dress code or did not attend Senior Assembly practice on May 14th, you will not participate in Senior Assembly. You are released from school after Senior Assembly.
16. Senior Assembly DVD's will be available for purchase for \$10.00 prior to Senior Assembly or on the day of Senior Assembly in the main hall entrance.
17. Sunday, May 17, 2026, at 2:00pm - BACCALAUREATE at FBC of GBC. All seniors must be at the church by 1:15pm and assemble in the education rooms to the left of the sanctuary.

18. Monday, May 18, 2026 - SENIOR WALK - Seniors will board buses at 7:30 a.m. to be transported to all lower level campuses. You will return to campus and report immediately to competition gym for graduation practice.
19. Monday, May 18, 2026 - GRADUATION PRACTICE at 10:30 a.m. in the Competition Gym at Mabank High School. You WILL NOT participate in the Graduation Ceremony if you do not attend Graduation Practice! IF YOU DO NOT ATTEND GRADUATION PRACTICE, YOU WILL NOT WALK AT GRADUATION. PRACTICE TIME IS 10:30 a.m. IF YOU ARE NOT IN THE BLEACHERS WHEN YOUR NAME IS CALLED TO BE SEATED FOR PRACTICE, YOU WILL NOT PARTICIPATE.
20. Tuesday, May 19, 2026, at 7:30 p.m. - GRADUATION at the Curtis Culwell Center in Garland. You must be at the center for line-up and dress check by 6:00 p.m. *Please allow plenty of time for travel to the Event Center. Graduates will be allowed to park in the Naaman Forest High School Parking Lot adjacent to the center. No parking fee will be required. Your cap and gown will serve as your fee.*
21. There is no limit to the number of guests you may invite to graduation. NO TICKET IS NEEDED FOR ADMITTANCE, but there is a charge for parking. ALL GUESTS MUST ADHERE TO ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE CURTIS CULWELL CENTER. Doors will open for guests at 6:00 p.m.

Dress Code for Senior Events

Appropriate dress and attire as well as good personal grooming will be expected of you during all senior activities. No inappropriate body parts will be exposed. You are seniors and you and your guests are expected to act maturely and responsibly. If you cannot abide by the following guidelines, you will not participate in any senior activity. *All activities are privileges that are afforded to you by this school. Nothing is required of Mabank High School, but to deliver to you your diploma. Please remember this!*

Baccalaureate and Graduation:

- **Girls** – Sunday dresses or appropriate pant suits with dress shoes (only dress sandals are allowed) with your cap and gown. Spaghetti strap, halter top, and strapless dresses *in good taste* can be worn at these two senior events only! Remember, the operative words are “*in good taste.*”
- **Boys** – White or light-colored dress shirts (button shirts only) with a dark tie and dress pants with your cap and gown. Clean blue jeans with **NO HOLES** can also be worn. You must be clean shaven. ***All boys will absolutely wear a tie with their shirts, or you will not be in Baccalaureate or Graduation!***
- **No shorts, casual sandals, tennis shoes, etc.** These are formal events and your attire should be appropriate for such an occasion.

Senior Assembly

- **Girls** – Nice dresses or pant suits with dress shoes or dress sandals. **Absolutely NO spaghetti straps, halter tops, off-the-shoulder dresses or tops, or strapless attire!** If worn, you must wear a jacket, sweater, etc. Dresses must be the appropriate length.
- **Boys** – Dress shirts and pants with dress shoes. Clean blue jeans with **NO HOLES** can be worn. **Absolutely NO shorts, hats, torn or ragged pants, sandals, tennis shoes, etc.** You **MUST** be clean shaven!
