

Revised Senior Timeline 2020

- May 6th 11:00am – 1:00pm (MHS horseshoe) – pick up Honor Cords, Top 10 Cords, Organization Stoles, & MSI Medallions

- Week of May 18th – Senior Checkout – further details will be sent out by campus administration

- May 23rd – Senior Celebration Parade & Graduation Ceremony - This senior celebration is MHS's way to celebrate our graduates in this unprecedented situation. We will have a parade through town with a drive-up graduation ceremony on the front steps at the high school immediately following. All spectators are expected to maintain social distancing guidelines outlined by local, state, and federal government, and the Center for Disease Control. No spectators will be allowed on campus or in campus parking.
 - Wear your cap & gown, stoles, and appropriate cords (photos will be taken with Mr. Koskelin). If you have not ordered a cap, gown, and stole, please contact Balfour t www.balfour.com or email joey.crouch@balfour-rep.com
 - Seniors need to be at the Pavilion by 12:30 pm for parade line-up. MHS staff will be there to give directions. Please remain in your vehicle at all times!
 - Only one graduate per vehicle (only exception is siblings).
 - Only one vehicle allowed per graduate; family may ride in the vehicle with the graduate.
 - Per TEA up-dated guidelines from May 5, 2020,"Members of the same household (5 individuals or fewer, excluding the graduate) may be present in a vehicle with the graduate".

 - You may decorate your vehicle **APPROPRIATELY**.
 - The parade route will be led by Mabank Police Department, similar to the annual rodeo parade. It is crucial that you **DO NOT** get out of order or make any stops during the parade.
 - The parade will conclude at the high school, where seniors will proceed around the campus to the horseshoe.
 - As each vehicle stops in front of the high school, the graduate may then (and only then) exit the vehicle. Your name will be announced and you will receive your diploma cover and have a photo taken with Mr. Koskelin.
 - After your photo is taken with Mr. Koskelin, you will then proceed to cross over the Senior Assembly bridge and receive your Senior Adjective. Another picture will be taken of you at the top of the bridge.
 - After crossing the bridge, Mrs. Groom will present you with a final packet that contains your actual diploma, memory book, returned baby pictures, a DVD of the Senior Assembly Baby Picture video, along with any other necessary information to complete the year.
 - Only the graduate is allowed to exit their vehicle! If your family would like to take pictures, they must do so from inside the vehicle.
 - A link to all of the photos will be sent out via Skyward Messenger.
 - After you have received your diploma packet, you will exit via Highway 175 service road.

In the event of inclement weather, the Senior Celebration Parade & Graduation Ceremony will be rescheduled for Saturday, May 30th. All of the times and guidelines outlined above will apply.

- The Senior Celebration Parade & Graduation Ceremony will be live-streamed on Mabank ISD's Facebook page. Please be aware that the streaming availability and quality will vary depending on your internet service, weather conditions, and location.
- If state and local guidelines allow, a formal graduation ceremony will be held on July 11, 2020 at Mabank High School.
