

## RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD REGARDING HAZARDOUS TRAFFIC CONDITIONS

WHEREAS, Education code 42.155(d) allows the Board of Trustees of *Mabank Independent School District* to obtain supplemental state funding for transporting regular, otherwise ineligible students who live within two miles of their school but who would be subject to hazardous traffic conditions if they walked to school:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of the *Mabank Independent School District* has determined that a hazardous condition exists because there are no walkways and uncontrolled major traffic arteries where students must walk along or cross.

And the Board of Trustees of *Mabank Independent School District* has identified the following specific hazardous areas in which such conditions exist:


1. All streets north of Highway 175 and south of Highway 334; east and west of Highway 198.
2. All streets west, north, and south of Highway 334 and Highway 274.

**Hazardous Traffic  
Conditions and  
High-Risk Areas**

If the District applies for the additional transportation allotment provided by the state for students who live within two miles of a school campus, the Board shall adopt a resolution to identify hazardous traffic conditions or areas presenting a high risk of violence within two miles of the school campus. The resolution shall include the specific hazardous or high-risk areas in which transportation shall be provided, and the District shall publish the locations of these routes. The Board shall adopt a revised resolution when necessary to accurately reflect changes to the conditions or areas.
