(Failure to follow guidelines can result in disqualification)

- > 3<sup>rd</sup> person (ex: he, she, they –don't use: I, you, we)
- > Write in complete sentences.
- > Past tense (ex: They went to the store. In other words, it has already happened.)
- Objective viewpoint (an unbiased statement, facts only)
- > This must be typed and have a title/headline and stapled or paper clipped to your application
