The teachers of MIS work diligently and passionately each day to provide your child with wonderful instruction that fosters personal growth and success, making MIS a great place to learn! We are constantly reviewing and revising our curriculum through multiple data analysis meetings to be able to best meet the needs of ALL students. We are not just preparing them to be successful on the state assessments, but preparing them to ready for junior high and beyond. We just ask each child to do their very best on everything they do!

State assessments, STAAR testing is just right around the corner, we can't wait for our kids to show up and show out! It is just about time for our kids to show us everything they know. We know they are going to do GREAT! We believe in each one of them. We ask that your child gets plenty of rest and that he/she has a healthy breakfast on the day of testing. Your child's attendance on testing days are extremely important, so we advise you to reschedule any Dr or Dentist appointments to a later date. It is also crucial that your child arrives to school on time and that he/she stays for the entire day.

We ask that if all possible any electronics (anything that can connect to the internet) be left at home on the day of testing. Students will have any electronic device that can connect to the internet taken up during testing and returned at the end of the 4 hour testing window. Comfy clothing is encouraged, so students are relaxed and ready to tackle the test, but please make sure they are in dress code (no pajamas, pillows, or blankets are allowed). 
