

**DAEP DRESS CODE: Students not in compliance will be SENT HOME. The day will count as a suspension day unless the student returns by 8:45 in complete dress code compliance.**

- **Shirts:** LIGHT Gray tee or LIGHT gray polo shirt, long or short sleeves
  - NO pockets
  - NO designs or logos.
  - NO shirts worn inside out.
  - NO **V-neck or scoop neck** shirts.
  - NO thumb hole cuff shirts
  - **NO flesh may show when both hands are raised.**
  - All shirts to be tucked in, except for sweatshirt worn over.
  - Shirt must be worn under sweatshirt
  - Colored shirts showing underneath the gray shirt are NOT permitted.
  - Gray, black, or white long-sleeved shirts may be worn UNDER the tee or polo for warmth.
  - **Gray, black, or white** plain sweatshirts may be worn OVER the shirt but will be removed during check-in.
  
- **Pants:** KHAKI (tan) SLACKS
  - **NO khaki jeans**
  - NO **cargo pockets or loops**, no decorations, no exposed metal zippers, tears, holes, etc.
  - NO skinny legs
  - NO low riders
  - NO stretch jeans
  - **Pant's waistband must rest at the top of the hip bone**
  - **Pockets must be able to pull out** and no secret/hidden small pockets
  - **Clothing must be appropriate size for individual student**
    - **Not too tight and not too baggy on student and DAEP staff will determine what is too tight and too baggy.**
  
- **Belt:** Brown or black solid leather (or leather-like) belt with PLAIN buckle
  - NO studs, designs, decorations, holes, patterns, etc.
  - NO cloth belts
  
- **Shoes:** Mostly solid colored white, brown, gray or black sneakers
  - **NO bright or neon colors on shoes**
  - NO boots or hard-soled shoes, sandals, & house shoes
  - NO shoes with secret pocket under the insole (Vans)  
*Shoestrings must be tied and either white or same color as shoes.*  
(Students may wear white, grey, or black crocks with socks & no decorations)  
**Socks:** white or black only & no neon colors or images on socks
  
- **Only ONE pair of pants** and **ONE pair of socks** may be worn at a time
  - Long thermal underwear is allowed during very cold weather.
  - **NO gym shorts may be worn underneath pants.**
  
- NO coats, jackets, hoodies, etc. may be worn inside the building
  - All outerwear will be hung on pegs in the cafeteria.
  
- NO makeup.
  
- Girls can only wear one bra. Regular bra and sports bra combo is not allowed
  
- NO nail color or artificial nails.
  
- NO jewelry.
  
- NO visible **TATTOOS--TATTOOS must be covered before entering the building**
  
- No metal objects.
  
- No dark glasses.
  
- No purses or wallets---unless student has a driving permit
  
- Girls may bring in a makeup bag with feminine products.
