Scholarship winners will be selected annually by evaluating the attached application, community activities, school involvement, political activities, and the applicant's original essay.

The Applicant must:

- Be entering into a field of study in the area of law enforcement, fire services or medical support.
- 2023 High School graduate
- Be a resident of Henderson County
- Be a legal resident of the United States of America with proof of birth certificate, passport or naturalization papers.
- Have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or greater
- Be attending a college, university, or technical school in the 2023-2024 school year

Additional Requirements:

- The applicant's completed application, essay, two letters of recommendation and supporting documents must be *received* at the Lone Star Republican Club post office box *no later than midnight, February 1, 2023.* A student may submit only one application. Late entries will be disqualified.
- Applicant must submit sealed transcripts to verify GPA.
- A letter of recommendation from one of the applicant's teachers and one personal recommendation (not a relative) must accompany the application.
- The application MUST be signed.
- A face-to-face meeting with judges may be required for finalists.
- The application must be complete. Any incomplete packages will be disqualified.
- All applications will be judged by the LSRCFR scholarship committee. The decision of the judges
 is final.

Essay Requirements:

- The essay must be an original work of the applicant on the topic of the essay title below.
- The essay must consist of a minimum of 500 words.
- The winning essay must be typed, using proper grammar, spelling and punctuation and all references footnoted. NO hand written papers will be accepted.
