- 2. Make sure to include all required attachments (see below) with your completed application. Scholarship applications and related attachments will not be returned. Please **do not** submit original copies.
- 3. Please return the completed application and attachments to your High School Counselor by the assigned deadline date.

REQUIRED ATTACHMENTS

Please submit the following attachments **along with your completed application** to your High School Counselor. Any applications submitted that do not have all the required attachments will be ineligible.

- 1. Copy of your high school transcripts with your GPA.
- 2. A list of activities and/ or honors (i.e. 4-H, FFA, Band, Dance, school or community awards).
- 3. Letter of acceptance from the University or College of your choice.
- 4. Essay typed essay with a maximum of two typed (8.5x11) pages. The essay should describe your educational and career goals, why you deserve the scholarship and the teacher who has inspired you most and why.

DEADLINE

Your scholarship entry must be submitted to your school counselor **by March 21, 2025**. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered. Students selected by CTCU will be contacted in late April or early May.
