Information and Criteria

- 1. The scholarship will be in the amount of \$1,000.00 for first year A&M students.
- 2. The student must attend Texas A&M University, College Station Campus, graduate from a Kaufman County high school, AND be a resident of Kaufman County.
- 3. The completed application must be scanned and e-mailed by April 1, 2025. <u>No exceptions will be made</u>. **kcaggiescholarships@gmail.com**. *If you do not receive a response, then your application has not been received.*

<u>COMPLETE</u> applications including transcript and letters of recommendation must be sent as <u>one attachment in PDF format</u>. DO NOT send individual pages or letters. Separate documents will not be considered. If you feel you need to add something, resend the application in full.

- 4. The scholarships will be awarded based but not limited to the following:
 - a. Academics
 - b. Demonstrated Leadership
 - c. Employment History
 - d. Evaluation of (optional) Essay Question
 - e. Recommendation of Counselor
 - f. Additional Letters of Recommendation
 - g. Financial Need
 - h. Extracurricular activities (excluding athletics)
- 5. Blinn Team accepted applicants will be considered on a limited basis. These applications will be considered only after all incoming freshman and returning students have been evaluated. Blinn Team awards will be based on scholarship money available in a particular year.
- 6. Applicants must have been accepted for admittance prior to the April 1, 2025 application deadline. Please include a copy of your acceptance letter with your application. <u>Applications without a copy of the acceptance letter will not be considered. This will be a document with the Texas A&M letterhead and your projected field of study i.e. nursing, engineering, business, etc.</u> Since scholarships are sent directly to the University, your UIN number is <u>REQUIRED</u> on your application.
- 7. If a student fails to attend Texas A&M College Station in the Fall of 2025, monies awarded must be returned. In addition, students must maintain full time status, meaning they are enrolled in <u>at least</u> 12 hours per semester.
- 8. <u>Scholarships will be awarded at the club's annual July Auction and Meeting.</u> <u>Recipients and their families are EXPECTED to attend. This event is typically</u> <u>held on the last Saturday in July. A formal invitation will be sent once the</u> <u>details are finalized.</u>
- 9. The Kaufman County A&M Club awards scholarships to <u>students</u>, not parents. Questions and interactions with the scholarship chair should be from the applicants deviations from this protocol will be noted and considered in the awards process. Please remember that members of the scholarship committee are volunteers. Decisions of the committee are final.
