First Responder Scholarship

Scholarship winners will be selected annually by evaluating the prescribed application, community activities, school involvement, and the applicant's original essay.

Applicant must:

- Be entering into a field of study in the area of law enforcement, fire services, or medical support.
- 2025 High School graduate
- Be a resident of Henderson County
- Be a legal resident of the United States of America with proof of birth certificate, passport, or Naturalization papers.
- Have a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or greater
- Be attending a college, university, or technical school in the 2025-2026 school year.

Additional Requirements:

- The applicant's completed application, essay, two letters of recommendation and supporting documents must be *received* at the Caring for America (CFA) post office box *no later than midnight, February 3, 2025.* Late entries will be disqualified.
- The applicants must provide sealed high school transcripts.
- A letter of recommendation from one of the applicant's teachers and a separate personal recommendation (**not a relative**) must accompany the application.
- The application MUST be signed.
- A face-to-face meeting with judges may be required for finalists.
- The application must be complete. Any incomplete packages will be disqualified.
- All applications will be judged by the CFA scholarship committee. The decision of the judges is final.

Essay Requirements:

- The essay must be an original work of the applicant on the questions below.
- The essay, combined answers, must consist of a minimum of 500 words. (APA format)
- The winning essay must be typed, using proper grammar, spelling and punctuation and all references footnoted. NO hand written papers will be accepted.

And

Why are you deserving of this scholarship?
