Chapter 1606 Kickers: An additional amount, called a kicker, may be added to the benefit of some chapter 1606 students who fall into a designated unmanned rating. The possible monthly kicker levels are \$100, \$200, and \$350.

Entitlement: 36 months. (Maximum of 48 months if eligible for more than one benefit chapter.)

## Re-Employment Rights under USERRA Statutes

The Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment Act of 1994 provides for reemployment of veterans who are recalled to Active Duty or voluntarily elect to convert to Active Duty status. Navy Reservists are protected from any type of employer prejudice while drilling, during Annual Training (AT) or in case of a recall to Active Duty.
