There will be file attachment options on the application link. Files do not need to be submitted separately. **ALL ATTACHMENTS WILL BE REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF SUBMISSION.**

What does a Red Bird do?

- Be well-versed in the knowledge of TVCC (training sessions are given)
- Be able to conduct themselves professionally as tour guides, since they are the face of TVCC to prospective students.
- Make visits to service area high schools to assist in recruiting presentations.
- Attend some college/career fairs
- Red Birds are required to be members of the Student Government Association
- Assist in major college events, projects, and other needs

Red Bird leaders are students on campus who are respected, responsible, and well-rounded individuals. Not only are they leaders to their peers on campus, but they are ambassadors to future students on TVCC's behalf. Red Birds is a great way to develop leadership skills and build your professional resume. ### FAQ's

- Students are not required to live on campus, but are required to schedule classes and outside activities (work, etc.) around their Red Bird Schedule.

  - Any events outside of those hours will be scheduled on an individual basis and are required.
  - Should an event occur between school/work hours, students will be expected to attend and will be excused from class if necessary.
- Red Birds are not required to have prior knowledge of TVCC, experience giving tours, or secretarial skills, but they are certainly welcome. All Red Birds are trained by enrollment staff and returning Red Birds.
